

Super indie artist at jazz fest

Indie artist Andrea Superstein, whose latest album *What Goes On* was Number 1 on CKUA recently, will be performing during the ninth annual Yardbird Festival of Canadian Jazz at the Yardbird Suite Nov. 6-14.

Superstein will team up with Start/Depart of Edmonton for a double bill Saturday, Nov. 14.

What Goes On is a collection of interestingly arranged standards, thoughtful originals and unique pop songs, marked by nods to jazz, trip hop and modern indie.

Super, as she is known in the biz, made her debut at the 2010 Vancouver International Jazz Festival where she was nominated for the Galaxie Rising Star Award. She has subsequently studied with Gretchen Parlato and Sara Gazarek and shared the stage on a triple bill with Laila Biali and Brandi Disterheft.

Also performing at the festival is the Tom Van Seters Trio, The Tara Kannangara Quintet, Audrey Ochoa, the David Blake trio, Zack Lober: P The Ancestry Project, Hookloop, the Mallory Chipman Quartet, Duchess, Griffith Hiltz Trio and the Melissa Lauren Quartet.
